- 449.48 Acres

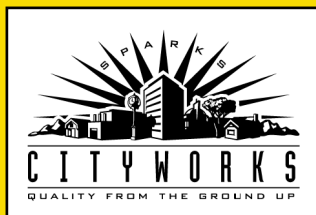
Details

- The park consist of 449.48 acres and is located south of the Foothills at Wingfield, east of Wingfield Springs and behind Fire Station 5.
- Amenities will include 6 adult softball fields, 2 little League fields, multi-purpose fields, 3 concession buildings and a maintenance building.
- Future amenities may include an interpretative center and an equestrian park.



Status

- The conceptual design for the park was approved by the Parks and Recreation Commission on May 24, 2006.
- On July 24, 2006 the City Council approved a Master Plan Amendment and Rezoning request to allow for the regional park.
- A mass grading permit has been issued for the site.
- This is the largest Public Works project in the history of the City and with 1.2 million square feet of artificial field turf, will have the largest artificial turf area in the United States.
