



Attention Summer Outburst Parents:

Summer Outburst is going to the Wild Island Water Park on Thursday, July 28th and Thursday, August 25th. The rules and procedures for these days are as follows:

- ❖ We are allowed to bring sack lunches into the park. However, glass is not permitted inside the park and we will not have access to a microwave. Please keep those two things in mind when packing your child's lunch for the day.
- ❖ 1st - 2nd grade children will stay with their assigned counselors at all times. These children will be required to wear life vests while in the lazy river. Life jackets are available for no charge at Wild Island but if you have one that fits your child, please send it. Sunscreen will be applied by staff every hour.
- ❖ 3rd - 7th grade children will be in small groups of at least 4 participants per group. They will be required to check-in with counselors and apply sunscreen every hour. Please send your child with a waterproof watch if you have one available for them to wear to help them keep track of the time.
- ❖ Counselors will regularly remind children of the next check-in time. If a child misses the check-in time they will sit out for 15 minutes with a counselor. If a child misses check-in a second time, he or she will remain with a counselor for the remainder of the day.
- ❖ The Wave Pool is off limits to all children and staff. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
